Monday 9th May 2022:

English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Tests:

- Paper 1 - Short Answer Questions (45 minutes)
- Paper 2 - Spelling Test (around 20 minutes)

Tuesday 10th May 2022:

English Reading Test:

- Single Reading Paper with around 3 different texts (60 minutes)

Wednesday 11th May 2022:

Mathematics Tests:

- Paper 1 - Arithmetic Paper (30 minutes)
- Paper 2 - Reasoning Paper (40 minutes)

Thursday 12th May 2022:

Mathematics Tests:

- Paper 3 - Reasoning Paper (40 minutes)
